Choose a Major course

Apply and pass exam

- Application periods for the Major Master's Course*:
- Mid December
 - Late July
- Entrance examination** periods for the Major Master's Course:
- Early February
 - Late August

3
Apply and enter the Sub-major

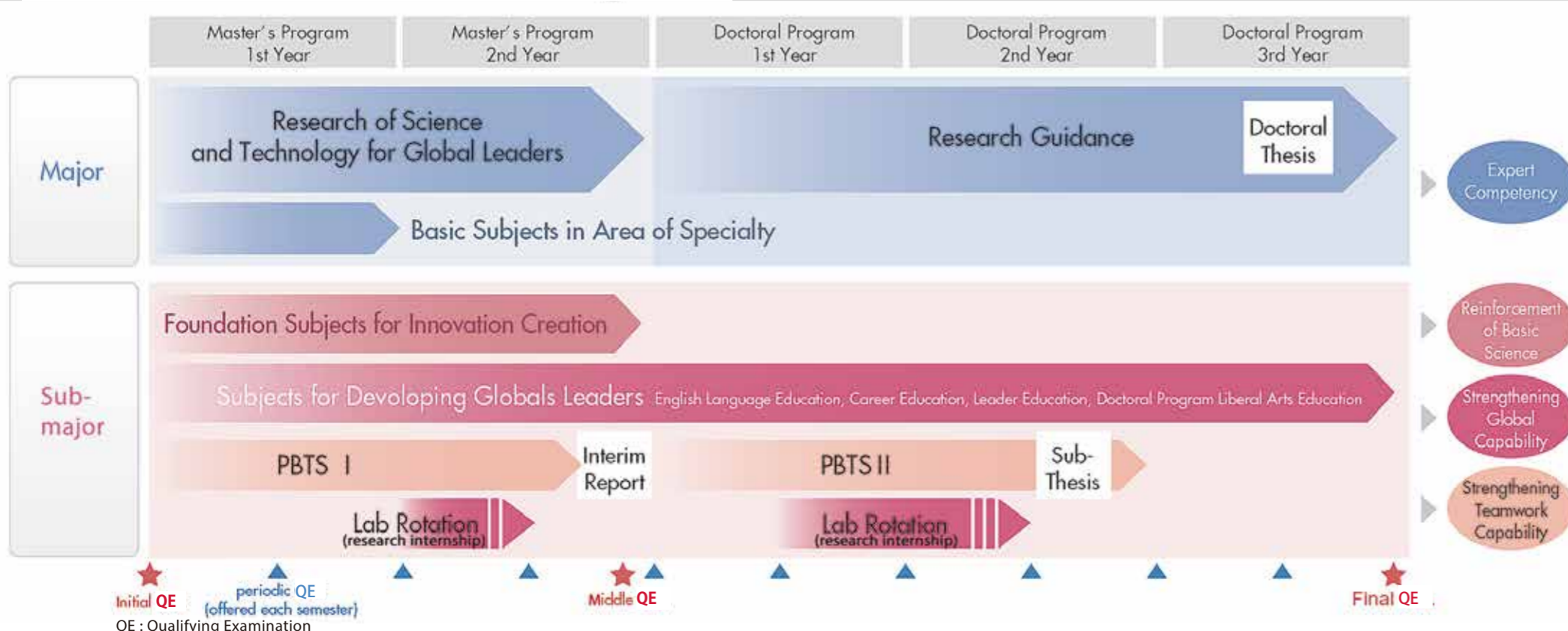
- Only applicants admitted to a Major are eligible to apply for the Sub-major course.
- Applications and entrance examinations periods are set up days after the entrance exam in the Major.

4
Start your graduate life in Japan!

- Students admitted in both the Major and Sub-major course are eligible to apply for a scholarship*** through the Sub-major.

* Prior acceptance from the applicant's supervising professor of choice is necessary for non-Japanese speaking candidates.
** Entrance examinations are taken in Ochanomizu University, Tokyo (travel expenses are not covered).
*** Scholarships are currently provided on yearly and competitive basis until March 2020. Conditions and taxes apply.
